

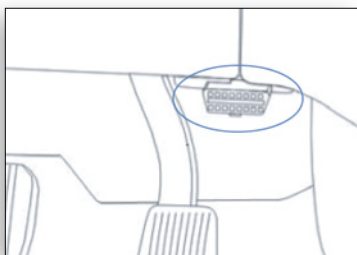
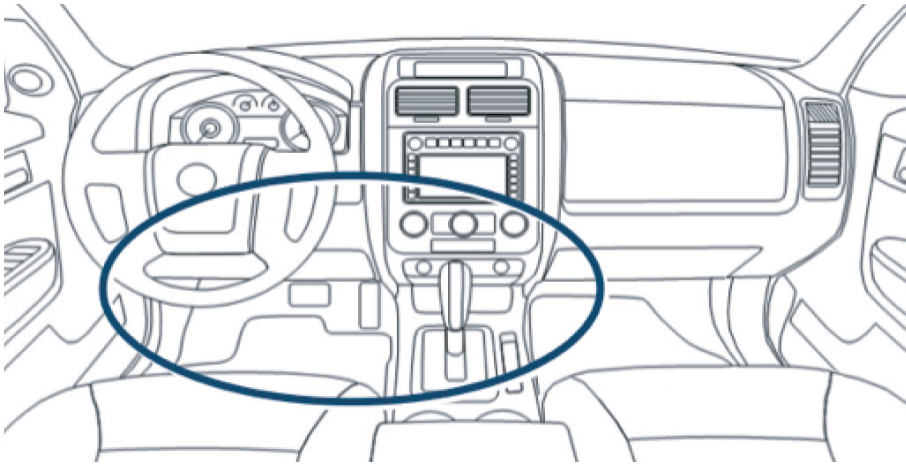

LMU-3030

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Automobiles built after 1996 are equipped with a diagnostic connection port - a sixteen-pin electrical connection either open to view or protected by a hinged cover.

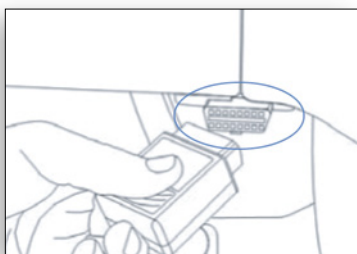
The location of this port varies between automobile manufacturers and models. It is usually located somewhere under the dashboard immediately in front of the driver's seat as seen in the illustration below:



STEP 1

Locate the vehicle's on-board diagnostic port. The port is generally located just under the bottom edge of a vehicle's dashboard (on the driver's side).

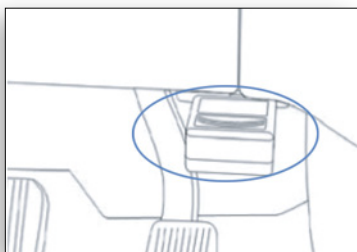
This connection port will serve as the installation port for your LMU-3030 plug-in module.



STEP 2

Remove all packing material from your LMU-3030 module and plug the LMU-3030 into the diagnostic connection port.

If the Connection Port is protected by a hinged cover, simply open the cover fully to ensure that it is out of the way before you plug-in the LMU-3030.



STEP 3

Once plugged in, the standard installation is completed; your LMU-3030 is now functional and you can operate your vehicle normally.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

HOW DO I INSTALL MY LMU-3030?

The Modus LMU-3030 is designed to be plugged into your vehicle's OBDII port, which is generally located around the base of the steering column. The installation instructions provide an instructional diagram on how to install the unit as well as the general area of the OBDII port. The Modus LMU-3030 has a clip which will secure the device into the OBDII port. It's that simple!

WHAT DOES THE LIGHT ON THE LMU-3030 MEAN?

The green LED may or may not light up momentarily when the device is installed in the vehicle. If it does not light up, do not worry as this is common and is not related in any way to the functionality of the device.

WILL INSTALLING THE LMU-3030 AFFECT MY VEHICLE WARRANTY?

The Magnuson-Moss Act, a federal law, provides protection regarding the original manufacturers' warranty to automobile owners who choose to have third party parts and equipment installed into their vehicles.

WHAT HAPPENS IF MY MECHANIC REMOVES THE LMU-3030 TO PERFORM ROUTINE MAINTENANCE ON MY VEHICLE?

The LMU-3030 will record that the device was removed and reinstalled. Otherwise, all functions go back to normal as soon as the device is reinstalled.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I PURCHASE A NEW VEHICLE AND I NEED TO MOVE THE LMU-3030 TO THE NEW VEHICLE?

When you notify your automobile insurance provider, or fleet manager, that you have purchased a new vehicle the Modus LMU-3030 will be re-programmed over the air if necessary.
